Overview of the Big Data Expo

The Big Data Expo, which is held in Guiyang each May, is representative of a comprehensive fair for the big data industry. Since its launch in 2015, the physical Big Data Expo has been held successfully for five consecutive years. Launched amidst the transformation of the global next-generation information industry, the Expo grows stronger as the sector thrives. Today, it's been an authoritative international platform for the world big data community, despite global changes intertwined with opportunities and challenges.


Over the past six years, the Expo has championed "Global Vision, National Interests, Industry Roles, and Corporate Responsibilities". The event comprises of five segments: "One Forum, One Exhibition, One Expo Release, Contests, and Related Activities", and it has been a great success annually. In 2019, it featured more than 20,000 guests and over 400 enterprises and institutional exhibitors, over 120,000 visitors attended the Expo, where they shared the benefits of big data evolvement and offered their input on industry developments.

As a promoter of the national big data development strategy, the Expo has been high on the agenda of leaders of China. In 2018 and 2019, Chinese President Xi Jinping sent a letter of congratulations on the opening of the Big Data Expo, and other government leaders, including Chinese Premier Li Keqiang, Former Vice Premier Ma Kai, and Wang Chen, Vice Chairman of the NPC Standing Committee, attended and addressed the first five Expos. Also, the event garnered attention and support from sectors across the globe, with António Guterres, the current Secretary-General of the United Nations, sending a congratulatory letter. Prominent figures, such as international dignitaries, government officials, corporate executives, experts, scholars, and representatives from media, associations and scientific research institutions, all congregated to lead the efforts in global cooperation on big data.

While upholding the national strategy, the Big Data Expo 2021 is set to respond to the need of businesses and debut emerging technologies. It will be a creative feast with both online and offline exhibitions arranged. Review of Previous Expos



The Big Data Expo came into being as the era of big data unfolds, and has lived up to the guiding principles embodied in President Xi Jinping's speech in his visit to Guizhou province. When the big data industry was taking shape, Guizhou province seized opportunities to take China's lead in pooling and energizing big data resources, laying a solid foundation for the Expo's launch.

The Expo first rose to fame in 2015 as the world's first themed exhibition on big data. The following year, the event was well received by all sectors across global society as Chinese Premier Li Keqiang attended and addressed the Expo's opening. Among others, chief executives of leading Internet companies, such as Baidu, Alibaba and Tencent, delivered fascinating keynote speeches. And the presence of such renowned companies as Alibaba, Huawei, Tencent, Microsoft, Oracle and Foxconn was a feast for the eyes.

With upgraded technology and a bigger market, the big data industry is experiencing exponential growth. The Expo provides a vital platform for global big data firms to share views and pursue common development, and its specialized, pioneering and internationalized features have been favored by countries and markets.

The Expo was elevated to the national level in 2017 and entered a new phase in 2018 as President Xi Jinping sent a congratulatory letter for its opening for the first time. The carefully orchestrated themes and activities have enabled the Expo to timely present the latest news and developments about the industry and to bring together globally-famed businesses, industry talents, academicians of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering, and university scholars. This is how the event searches for possible business opportunities as the big data industry moves forward.

BIG DATA EXPO

Building on its past successes, the Big Data Expo 2019 made breakthroughs in terms of the scale of the event, the tier of the special guests, the way it was organized, and the exhibits.

Regarding international exchanges, the Organizing Committee, together with the Moroccan Digital Development Agency (DDA), co-hosted the high-level dialogue on big data and global poverty reduction. To spread Guizhou's practices of poverty eradication, a themed exhibition section about big data plus poverty alleviation was put in place. The Expo hosted a record number of overseas exhibitors, which accounted for one third of total exhibitors.


Regarding **forums and meetings**, the Expo dove into trending topics in the industry by orchestrating an array of high-level dialogues and forums. On its sidelines, various business activities, such as the Matchmaking for Chinese Big Data Investors and Developers and the Welcoming Cocktail Reception, were held to offer entrepreneurs and investors opportunities to network.

Regarding **services to companies**, the meticulous and thoughtful arrangements allowed 448 exhibitors to experience the fascinating event and showcase their products. The 2019 Expo Releases included ten cutting-edge technologies, ten new techniques, 20 new products and nine business models, which were created by global companies as a way to guide the industry forward.

Regarding **entrepreneurship and innovation**, the host of six outstanding competitions, including the AI Global Contest, involved 2,500 entrepreneurial teams from 20 countries and regions. Six observation routes with 32 sites were meticulously designed by the Organizing Committee to foster an enabling ecosystem for entrepreneurship in "China Data Valley".







2020

To respond to the coronavirus pandemic, the organizers took an innovative approach to hosting the Expo by putting relevant activities online. With that, "the Never-ending Big Data Expo — Global Communication Campaign 2020, China's first global communication" effort jointly taken by an international expo and the media, was held from May 26 through September 30, 2020.

The online Expo witnessed the host of 78 events, including one Expo Investors Forum, 52 releases, eight dialogues, ten interviews, four salons, and three other activities. With everything held online, the Expo introduced the industry achievements and latest developments in 2020 and reminisced on the success of the past five years, giving 813,300 visitors an exciting and different way to explore the event and identify business opportunities.

Among others, the Expo Investors Forum made possible the integration of technologies with financial resources, enabling more quality projects to be commercialized as it created opportunities for cooperation on global big data projects through corporate roadshows and observation tours for investors.



The upcoming Expo will present its selected cutting-edge technology, policy documents, public welfare campaigns, and business achievements.



Global Competitions



By hosting multiple themed competitions, including the Al Global Contest, the Expo aims at identifying projects that prove rewarding and getting these startup projects commercialized. Continued efforts have been made to make these events diverse, down-to-earth, cutting-edge, and international, and to enrich them by integrating with exhibitions and forums.



Other Activities



The Expo will also include the business investment event, activities of foreign embassies and consulates in China, big data observation tours, and the "Night of the Data Valley", among others. They are designed to showcase what big data has to offer by taking advantage of Guizhou as China's first comprehensive pilot zone for big data at the national level.


